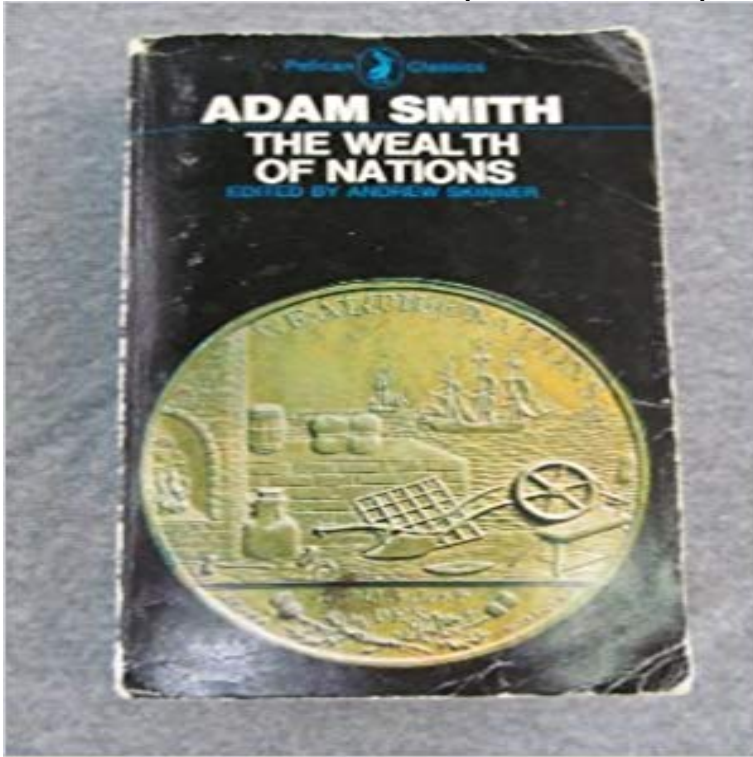


The Wealth of Nations [Books I-III]



By pin-pointing the division of labour as a major explanation of economic growth, Adam Smith laid the foundations of economic theory in general and of classical economics in particular. But Andrew Skinner shows in his introduction to this edition that the real sophistication of *The Wealth of Nations* lies less in individual areas of economic analysis than in its overall picture of a vast analogical system - a capitalist economy - in which all the parts can be seen simultaneous interaction with each other. Moreover he stresses that Smith's view of society was not a merely economic one, and that *The Wealth of Nations* is far from being an apologia for unregulated business enterprise: Smith was a pains to show that economic advance can have undesirable social consequences, and that labour which is economically unproductive can be beneficial to society at large.
